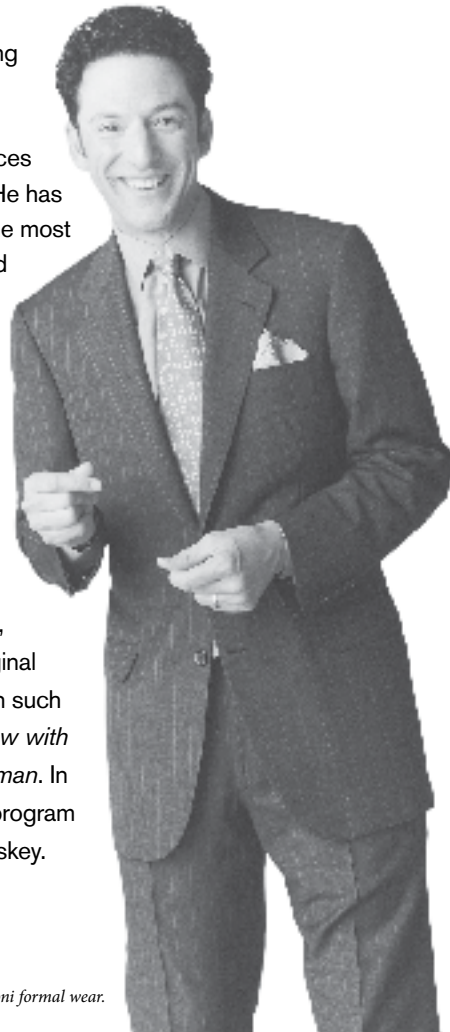

Guitarist and vocalist **John Pizzarelli** is among the prime revivalists of the Great American Songbook. He has established himself as a consummate entertainer through live performances around the world as well as studio recordings. He has recorded 23 albums as soloist or bandleader, the most recent of which is *With a Song in My Heart*, and he has collaborated with other artists on more than 100 additional recordings, including discs with Natalie Cole, James Taylor and his father, guitar legend Bucky Pizzarelli. He is featured on the Grammy Award-winning CD *Songs from the Neighborhood: The Music of Mr. Rogers*.

Known especially for his interpretations of jazz standards by Nat "King" Cole and Frank Sinatra, Pizzarelli has also earned recognition for his original music. He has given numerous performances on such popular television programs as *The Tonight Show with Jay Leno* and *The Late Show with David Letterman*. In addition, he co-hosts the nationally syndicated program *Radio Deluxe* with his wife, singer Jessica Molaskey. For more information, visit johnpizzarelli.com.
